I believe the output (sheets per minute) with Kinkos copiers vs. Minolta copier that is under current lease at Seguin is much slower.

Given the limited human resources to run the copiers - and volumes of copies needed for larger campuses is going to be biggest problem. (student count is 600+ at Seguin).

The second problem will be the up front cost. The classroom printers will not have full cartridges to run, therefore the \$200 cartridges will devastate the current budget for this type of supply for 30+ printers.

Another problem I expect is supplies (i.e. staples, toner, drums, roller, etc...). Supplies are not in kinkos contract, but are rather an addition to the copier expense.

And last, the ability to print color copies for elementary teachers will be a hardship with regard to limited color copiers per campus. Elementary teachers use visuals as a teaching tool in and of itself. The resources on the internet, etc.. that they currently are able to print in color will be limited to use of the color copiers in the building.

The limited color copiers also does not support the new dataportal student information and assessment information which are great teaching tools. You will be able to look at the data, but all the color coding, graphics, etc. will only be available in black for teachers to print - the very persons we want to have the data in a very presentable - user friendly manner.

If there are solutions to this, let us know.
