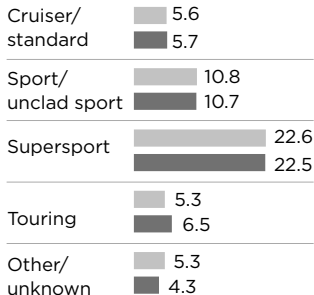


Motorcycle accident deaths

Nationwide, death rates by type of motorcycle in 2005 changed little from 2000, even though there were about 1,500 more deaths.

Common injuries

From 1998 through 2007, Methodist Health Systems' trauma center in Dallas treated 682 patients for motorcycle-related injuries. The percentage of patients with the following injuries:

Head and
face: 49%

Neck: 16%

Chest: 38%

Abdominal
or pelvic: 19%

Body surface
trauma: 59%

Extremities: 59%



NOTE: Percentages will not add up to 100 because many of the patients had multiple injuries.
